Next weekend, on the Feast of Christ the King, we will mark the beginning of a year in which we celebrate the anniversaries of two significant milestones in the history of our parish - 200 years ago, in 1820, our parish Church of St Mary's, Killyclogher was dedicated; and 40 years ago, in October 1979, Christ the King Church was opened.

These churches, together with St Mary's, Knockmoyle (1800) and Corpus Christi, Mountfield (1953), have served many generations of Cappagh parishioners. To this day, they remain important centres in the life of our parish - where God is worshipped, where our Christian faith is celebrated, where we are formed as disciples of Jesus Christ, and where our community life is nourished.

To mark the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Christ the King Church, you are invited to a Triduum (3days) of Prayer, Celebration and Thanksgiving on the evenings of Friday 22<sup>nd</sup>, Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> and Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> November; during which Guest Speakers will deliver a reflection.

#### Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> November / CTK / 7.30pm

Margueritte Hamilton will give a talk on "prayer and worship" - what prayer is, how to pray, and the importance in any family and community of worshipping God. Margueritte is from Derry and is the former principal of Thornhill College. She is actively involved with the Columban Community in Derry, which is a lay association of the faithful dedicated to the service of the marginalised and committed to working for peace, reconciliation and healing.

## Saturday 23rd November / CTK / 6.30pm Vigil Mass

Michael Kelly will give a talk on "being a prophet in today's world" - Being a prophet today by witnessing to our faith with our words and actions, by encouraging each other in the faith, and by passing on the faith to future generations. Michael, a native of Strathroy, is a well-known and award winning writer and broadcaster specialising in religious and social affairs. He is also editor of the Irish Catholic newspaper.

#### Sunday 24th November / CTK / 7.30pm

Jacinta Crockford, a co-worker with the Missionaries of Charity (Mother Teresa's Sisters) will give a talk on "their ministry of caring for the most marginalised in society" - inviting us to reflect on building parish and community life through our caring for one another, especially the most vulnerable.

This Triduum will mark the beginning of our Cappagh 2020 celebrations - a year-long series of events marking the 200<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of our Parish Church, culminating in a parish mission later in 2020.

While these anniversary celebrations are about our past, they are also importantly about our future. On Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> November at 7.30pm, in the Parish Centre, Killyclogher, we are holding an open meeting and discussion on the present and future life of our parish. At this evening, the results of the recent parish survey will be presented and discussed. There will be a presentation on a vision for our parish for the future followed by open discussion and questions. Tea and refreshments will be served.

Our parish has grown and changed over the past 200 years. Over the generations, the parishioners of Cappagh have met many ups and downs, many joys and challenges, with a spirit of commitment, determination and resilience. We have always been, and will continue to be, a people of faith and hope. With the strong community spirit that marks our parish, let us journey together, into the future with faith and trust in God, who is working with us and through us, so that we will hand-on to future generations a strong and faith-filled parish.
