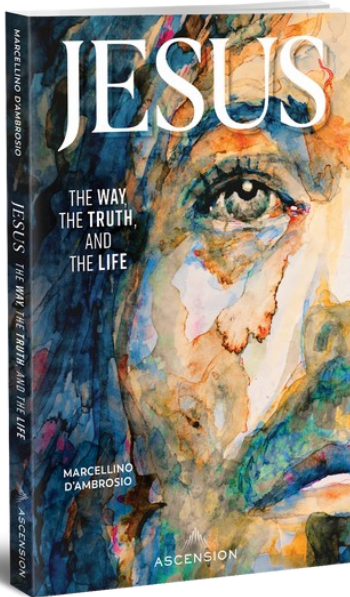

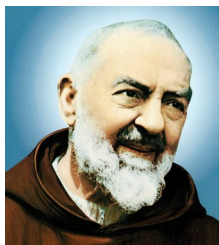
**BLESSING OF THE GRAVES**
