*Our 9 day Novena commences on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> January and concludes on Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> January: the Feast day of St John Bosco, Patron of the Youth.*

Born in Italy, St John Bosco was a friend of the young and a teacher in the ways of God. He worked with street children and juvenile delinquents; and in contrast to the harshness with which they were treated at the time - he developed teaching methods based on love and kindness.

St Bosco was canonized in 1934 by Pope Pius XI and was given the title "Father and Teacher of Youth."
