Mission Sunday is a day for us to reflect on the contribution we, as Irish people, have made to this mission in the past and how we live it today.

Mission was understood as going abroad to countries where the Church was not strong or to places where people suffered from poverty or conflict. This is still valid today.

Mission was also seen as a task primarily for priests or religious, with a few lay Missionaries, and their work was much supported by the generosity of those “at home.”

Today Pope Francis is encouraging all the baptised to more actively assume their responsibility as “missionary disciples.”

At the end of every Mass we are told “Go in peace, to love and serve the Lord.”

As we leave the church we are given a clear instruction - a mission.

Our mission? As Christians, to be ready and willing and able.

Our challenge? To reflect on our faith experience, seek more knowledge about the Scriptures and teachings of the Church and seek to articulate it meaningfully to ourselves and to others.
