St Mary Magdalene stood by the Cross of Jesus. With two other women she discovered the empty tomb and she was granted an appearance of the Risen Lord early the same day, from which incident she has been described as *“the apostle to the apostles”*.

The Gospels give no warrant for identifying her with the “woman who was a sinner” who anointed Christ's feet (Lk7:37) or with Mary the sister of Martha who also anointed him (Jn12:3).
