ALL SOULS Indulgence

1. From noon on 1 Nov until midnight on 2 Nov all who have confessed, received Holy Communion & prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father & Hail Mary, or any prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, & reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1 Nov. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1-8 Nov.

2. The faithful who visit a cemetery & pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1-8 Nov. Conditions above apply also for this.
