The Parish Finance Council present the Annual Financial Report for 2016 and are pleased to announce the continued responsible management of the parish's financial affairs. Savings have been made in operating costs and pastoral expenses have been met.

Thanks to your continuing support and generosity, all loans have been fully paid. 2016 saw an increase in the weekly collections (which includes £47,634 donated to the Parish Development Fund). I am pleased to tell you the Gift Aid claim increased again this year (2015's Gift Aid contains 2yrs of contributions). £50,518 was raised from the Parish draw, £3925 from the monthly Parish Dance and £6,620 from additional fundraising events (including the Fashion Show and Advent Gospel Evening).

During 2017, your contributions will be used to maintain parish properties and build on our religious pastoral programmes. Future renovation works, in particular work to the Parish Centre, will impact on us financially. The Killyclogher & District Development Association (KADDA) is now up and running and will soon update us on the results of the household survey and present plans for an updated parish centre.

Our parish is entirely funded by your financial contributions and I take this opportunity to thank you for your generosity in supporting the mission of our parish. I also wish to thank our fundraisers, the organisers of the parish draw, those who promote the draw and everyone who participates and supports it.

The parish is also enriched by hundreds of volunteers who give so generously of their time and talent to serve our community in various ministries, pastoral outreaches and parish groups. Your gifts are invaluable and truly appreciated. It is also a great testament to our faith to see growth in many areas of ministry and in particular to see the great work of our parish youth. With them on-board the future looks bright in Cappagh!

Currently the parish is in a relatively good financial position; however we still have much work to do. Financially, we must ensure that we stay within our budget plan, continue to monitor expenses and continue to save to ensure that future projects and works can be funded. Thank you most sincerely for your continuing support.
