In recent years, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, our pastoral care ministry has been on hold. However, we are excited to announce that we are relaunching this ministry in the coming weeks.

A 'TRIDUUM OF PRAYER FOR THE SICK' will take place on Tuesday 7th, Wednesday 8th, and Thursday 9th February, at 7.30pm in Christ the King Church, Strathroy. Each evening, guest speakers will help us to reflect on sickness as an invitation to serve Christ, to unite ourselves with Him, and to find hope in His word.

Then, on Sunday 12th February at 6pm, young people from our parish will lead a holy hour of prayer for the sick, during which priests will be available to administer the Sacrament of the Sick and to hear Confessions.

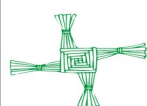
REV MICHAEL MCCAUL
