

## World Meeting of Families 2018 : Update

**Pope Francis meeting with newly married/engaged couples:** The selected couples will be contacted directly by the Archbishop of Dublin and formally invited to the event. **Tickets** for the RDS congress, Festival of Families and Croke Park will be emailed by or around the end of July 2018. If you are attending all three, tickets may arrive separately. **Knock** is a ticket only event. No one should think of going without a ticket.

**RDS Congress:** First workshop starts at 10am with Mass each afternoon at 4.30pm.

**Festival of Families, Sat 25<sup>th</sup> Aug:** Gates open at Croke Pk at 4pm. Festival begins at 6.30pm. Pope Francis will arrive at 7pm. Festival will end around 9pm.

**Papal Mass, Sun 26<sup>th</sup> Aug:** The Mass will start at 3pm. Numbers for the Mass have been set at 500,000. Pilgrims will be allocated a colour coded walking route and entrance gate to the Park. You can only enter through the gate you have been allocated.

**People attending any of the events should carry some form of photographic ID and have their tickets with them; to ensure the smooth running of the events.**
