May they wholeheartedly devote themselves to prayer and penance;

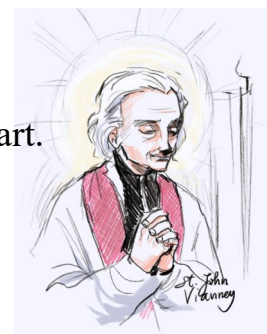
be examples of humility and poverty; shining models of holiness;

## ST. JOHN VIANNEY (1786-1859) : PATRON OF PRIESTS.

Feast Day: 4<sup>th</sup> August

Known as the "Curé d'Ars"; St John Vianney during his lifetime had to contend with poverty, military service and his own intellectual shortcomings in order to become a priest.

In 1818, he was sent to care for the people of Ars, a small, obscure French village.

He was always available to hear confessions, spending up to sixteen hours a day in the confessional. The marvellous gift of the unlearned priest for seeing into the depths of the soul brought the word to Ars. Ars became known as "the great hospital of souls."

In 1929 he was canonised by Pope Pius XI who named him the "heavenly patron of all parish priests throughout the world."
