Greenhill:

Please bring a container with you to collect the Holy Water, which you can use to bless your loved ones grave.*

Remembrance:

Annual Mass of Remembrance, for those who died in our parish during the past year, will be celebrated on Wednesday 12th November in St. Mary's Church, Killyclogher at 7.30pm. *If you have a family member who died in the past year but didn't live in the parish; and you would like them included in this Mass -contact the parish office by Tues 11th November*

On 2nd November, it is especially important to recall the Church's teaching that there is indeed a Purgatory in which the souls of the saved, but imperfect, are awaiting the fulfilment of their purification and healing, and that these souls can be greatly helped by the prayers, sacrifices and Masses offered by the living. This is an aspect of the Catholic patrimony that must not be forgotten or de-emphasised. Justice demands that our brothers and sisters in the faith who have died find in us faithful friends - who acknowledge that it is indeed a good and pious things to pray for the dead.

*Into your hands, O Lord, we humbly entrust our brothers and sisters.
In this life you embraced them with your tender love;
deliver them now from every evil and bid them enter eternal rest.
The old order has passed away: welcome them into paradise,
where there will be no sorrow, no weeping nor pain,
but fullness of peace and joy with your Son and the Holy Spirit forever and ever.
