As we watched the election of Pope Leo, it was to St. Peter's Basilica at the Vatican that we turned. But one of the Pope's first visits was across the city to his cathedral church of St. John Lateran.

Today, as we mark the dedication of that great Church, we are reminded that God calls us to set aside divisions and be of one mind and heart as members of one universal Church. The dedication of every Church is about Jesus Christ and about worship in spirit and in truth.

Today's first reading helps us to reflect and understand that the role of the Church and of the Pope is to give us life. The second reading reminds us that we are the Church, the temple of God. Each of us is a temple of God and together we are God's people.

Finally, in today's Gospel, from Saint John, we understand how the body of Christ points to resurrection, for Him and for us. We are to recognise in all of this the hand of God: Jesus dies for us and we must die for one another. This is the Church and this is why we celebrate the dedication of a Church.

The Bishop of Rome, our Pope, can lead us to walk with Christ - but we must be the ones to walk.
