*The relationships in the Holy Trinity are relationships of love; and the unity and harmony of life in the Trinity is to be the aim of each parish community.*

God's very nature is in relationship, among three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. They are (and God is) a community of love, showing us how to love.

That can seem like heady stuff. So what does that insight have to our daily lives?

To begin with, it can encourage us to enter more deeply into relationships with one another. Notice how many passages in St. Paul's letters are about the relationships within the early Christian communities. In most cases, Paul is primarily talking not about private religious practices but about interpersonal relationships. Now much of this has to do with the fact that these communities often were dealing with internal conflicts. But it is also reflective of the fact that if we are to live like the Father, Son and Holy Spirit - that is, like the Trinity - it will mean that we find God through relationships.

So Paul tells us how to be relational: "Mend your ways, encourage one another, live in peace, and the God of love and peace will be with you."

All this serves as a reminder against the kind of Christianity that is just about "me and God." Why do I need other people for my salvation when they annoy me so much? Why do I need a community when it's so imperfect? Why do I even need the church, when some of its members are so homophobic, or misogynistic or just plain sinful? Because we are, even in the face of all those annoyances, imperfections and sins, called to be in relationships, called to love and called to sacrifice. Called to be relational. Called to be, in a word, like the Trinity.
